

Criteria for the **Rev. Stanley J. Bezuska, S.J. Achievement Award for Mathematics Teaching and Learning** award. This is an award to honor the commitment and excellence of teachers of mathematics in levels PreK – 16. The nominee should be an outstanding teacher of mathematics or mathematics education both within their school, district, or institution of higher education and the ATMIM community of members.

- 15 years of teaching mathematics PreK - 16
- demonstrated excellence in stimulating students in their mathematics learning
- history of presentations at the ATMIM Winter or Spring conferences
- service to the ATMIM

Your nomination should include:

- ✓ the nominee's name, address, telephone number, email address, school or higher education institution, and years of teaching or mathematics service.
- ✓ Nominator's name, telephone number, and email address
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation
- ✓ A letter, not longer than 2 doubled-spaced pages, which should provide information about the nominee's activities, publications, presentations, and service to ATMIM
